GOD'S PLAN FOR US

God wants all to be saved (justified) | By grace through faith

1 Timothy 2:4 (NIV)

“...who wants all people to be saved and to come to a knowledge of the truth.”

God wants all to be sanctified | The process of becoming like Jesus through a set apart lifestyle

1 Thessalonians 4:3 (NIV)

“It is God’s will that you should be sanctified: that you should avoid...”

God wants all to walk in freedom | Freedom in your SPIRIT, BODY & SOUL (mind, will, emotions)

Galatians 5:1 (NIV)

“It is for freedom that Christ has set us free. Stand firm, then, and do not let yourselves be burdened again by a yoke of slavery.”

God wants all who belong to Him to be blessed

Jeremiah 29:11 (NIV)

“For I know the plans I have for you,” declares the Lord, “plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future.”

Unfortunately, many of us don’t move beyond the point of salvation. Even if we get saved, we struggle to live the set apart life and as a result remain in bondage in our soul. Our soul is made up of our mind, will and emotions. This course is designed to teach us how to practically attain all that God has promised us, using the nation of Israel’s journey from slavery, through the wilderness into the Promised Land as a symbolic example.



God supernaturally saved the Israelites from the bondage of Egypt

Exodus 3:7-10 (NIV)

“The Lord said, “I have indeed seen the misery of my people in Egypt. I have heard them crying out because of their slave drivers, and I am concerned about their suffering. So I have come down to rescue them from the hand of the Egyptians and to bring them up out of that land into a good and spacious land, a land flowing with milk and honey—the home of the Canaanites, Hittites, Amorites, Perizzites, Hivites and Jebusites.”

God required the nation of Israel to live a set apart life
Leviticus 20:26 (NIV)

“You are to be holy to me because I, the Lord, am holy, and I have set you apart from the nations to be my own.”

God gives the nation of Israel the Promised Land
Deuteronomy 1:8 (NIV)

“See, I have given you this land. Go in and take possession of the land the Lord swore he would give to your fathers—to Abraham, Isaac and Jacob—and to their descendants after them.”

God continually expresses His desire to bless the nation of Israel

Deuteronomy 28:1-2 (NIV)

“If you fully obey the Lord your God and carefully follow all his commands I give you today, the Lord your God will set you high above all the nations on earth. All these blessings will come on you and accompany you if you obey the Lord your God”

The nation of Israel eventually crossed over from the wilderness into the Promised Land (the land of Canaan) under the leadership of Joshua (Moses’s successor). Little by little they had to conquer one enemy at a time.

The conquest of the Promised Land is a **TYPE** of all the promises of God for believers in Christ. Their promised land was physical; our promised land is spiritual.

The land of Canaan was given from God, but it was not possessed without a battle

Deuteronomy 7:22 (NIV)

“The Lord your God will drive out those nations before you, little by little. You will not be allowed to eliminate them all at once, or the wild animals will multiply around you.”

Likewise, the kingdom of God will only be established in our lives through the confrontation of the enemy

Matthew 11:12 (AMP)

“From the days of John the Baptist until now the kingdom of heaven suffers violent assault, and violent men seize it by force [as a precious prize].”

Even Jesus confronted the enemy; he healed the sick and cast out demons.

Mark 16:15-18 (NIV)

“He said to them, “Go into all the world and preach the gospel to all creation. Whoever believes and is baptized will be saved, but whoever does not believe will be condemned. And these signs will accompany those who believe: In my name they will drive out demons; they will speak in new tongues; they will pick up snakes with their hands; and when they drink deadly poison, it will not hurt them at all; they will place their hands on sick people, and they will get well.”

STRONGHOLDS

HITTITES

This name means terror.

Fear, confusion and discouragement

GIRGASHITES

The meaning of the word "Girgashite" is as one who returns back from a pilgrimage.

Earthy, build their houses using clay, not stable in their mind-set, doubleminded

AMORITES

They were people who were arrogant and boastful in their speech.

Exaggerated self-esteem, pride, critical, fault finding

CANAANITES

This name means merchants who humiliate.

Financial giants, motivated by greed, lust for the accumulation of earthly and material wealth

PERIZZITES

People who had separated themselves and lived in unprotected, unwalled villages.

No discipline, no restrictions

HIVITES

They claimed to offer a good lifestyle.

Very luxurious life and not a sacrificial one

JEBUSITES

They were people who exploited and polluted others through immoral activities.

Impurity, immoral



The enemy works and establishes strongholds in darkness.

Strongholds are attitudes and behaviours that continue in our life because we think, "that is just who I am."

A stronghold is deception (wrong philosophy, reasoning, or thought pattern) filled with hopelessness. It determines or establishes a behaviour pattern and keeps one tied to an addiction.

EXAMPLES OF STRONGHOLDS INCLUDE:

- Fears, insecurities, anxieties, jealousy, drug addictions, alcohol addictions, pornographic addictions, abuse, anger, control, manipulation, cursing, drunkenness, occultism activities, inappropriate language, depression.
- Ungodly ideology, philosophy, reasoning, thought patterns and world view by which one lives.
- **We are all products of our past**, we have shaped our behaviour patterns, defence mechanisms and the systems by which adversity, trials and tragedy are handled.

DELIVERANCE FROM THE ENEMY

This course teaches us to do battle with the enemy and the strongholds he has established in our lives GODS WAY and as a result how to walk into freedom in our soul, that is our mind, will and emotions.

- The truth sets us free
- The cross is our focal point
- Wherever there is a confrontation of kingdoms, God's kingdom will always win
